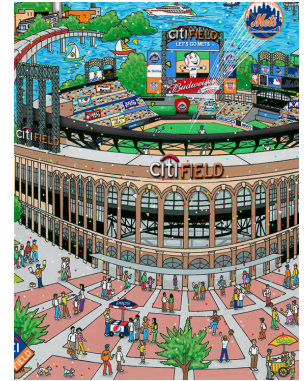
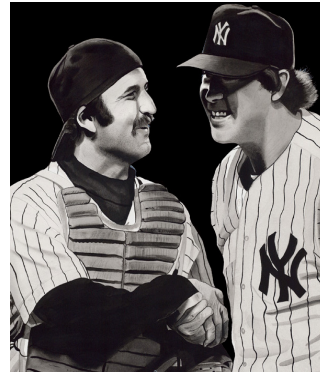




## ***NEW YORK BASEBALL ART***

***New York Baseball Art***

New York, NY –June 5 - RCS FINE ART, the art advisory firm, announced today that the summer exhibit at 1251 Avenue of the Americas has opened, and it highlights artwork about the exciting game of baseball. The exhibition, titled *New York Baseball Art* will be on view in the lobby of 1251 Avenue of the Americas, located at 49th Street and Sixth Avenue, which is accessible to the public from 9 AM – 5 PM, Monday through Friday.

The artists include **LeRoy Neiman**, known as the Father of Contemporary Sports Art and a member of "Who's Who of American Art" and **Graig Kreindler**, a skillful artist whose historically accurate paintings are sought after by collectors world-wide. Also included are **Charles Fazzino**, an artist at the forefront of 3-d pop art and **James Fiorentino**, a young talent in the competitive sports art market. These artists' works can be seen alongside a print of the 1951 impressionist-style painting, "Night Baseball" by **Marjorie Phillips**, a founder of the Phillips Collection in Washington D.C., and a rare poster featuring the thirty Dodgers players, who brought home the first world series title to Brooklyn (beating the NY Yankees), along with their coaches, owner, and manager. The poster memorializes an homage to the home team by modernist poet, **Marianne Moore**.

Baseball, "America's pastime", is part of our shared heritage; it is something that ties generations and communities together and helps define the American experience. It is entrenched in our popular culture, and affects our literature, our language, our politics, and our arts. Artists, poets, everyone responds to the sport's ambition, vigor, and history. This exhibit will delight lovers of baseball and art.
