*Euphoria: Painted Sculpture*

RCS Fine Art presents a special exhibition of sculpture at 1251 Avenue of the Americas located in the Lobby Gallery and open to the public, M-F; January 11 through April 11, 2018. The exhibit features artwork by Hudson Valley artists: Susan Crowe, Beth Humphrey, Scott Garrette, and Susan Parker; all of whom construct colorful, small-scale sculptures in a mix of materials, from cardboard, to paper, to Plexiglass, to pigmented wax and color-coded telephone wire. The six brightly-colored sculptures on view inside the busy corporate lobby space offer viewers an entry to contemporary formal art. Each artwork is exhibited with a label that explains aspects of the artwork and the artist's art-making process.

This exhibition is presented in partnership with Mitsui Fudosan America, Hines, and RCSFA an art consulting firm that provides exhibition and art advisory services to corporations, museums and historic collections. The gallery at 1251 AoA is located in the lobby of 1251 Avenue of the Americas, 49<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The gallery is open to the public M-F: 7 a.m.-7 p.m.
